This letter is to inform you about University of Amsterdam (UvA) construction activities scheduled to be carried out shortly in your neighbourhood.

Oude Turfmarkt tunnel asphalt replacement

Maintenance work will commence Monday, 29 September in the Oude Turfmarkt tunnel (next to numbers 141-143). The asphalt layer in the tunnel leading to the Special Collections and Allard Pierson Museum courtyard will be replaced. The work will be very noisy during the first couple of days, in particular when the old asphalt is being removed. Access to the tunnel during the day will be restricted. If the tunnel is blocked off when you need to pass, you may ask the workers on site to let you through.

Pedestrians may also use the passageway via the Allard Pierson Museum. The tunnel will be completely closed on the day when the new asphalt layer is being applied. This is scheduled for Monday, 6 October. Low-noise equipment will be used wherever possible to minimise noise nuisance. The project is scheduled to take approximately two weeks. Work will begin at 7:00 and end at 17:00.

Painting

The courtyard behind the Special Collections is currently being painted. The work at this location will be finished next week and the scaffolding will be taken down. Painting will shortly commence on the side of the building next to Turfdraagsterpad (the wall across from building BG 1 and BG2 - next to numbers 9-17). Scaffolding will be set up at this location for the work. Work will begin at 7:00 and end at 19:00. It has been agreed that activities that cause a lot of noise will be carried out after 8:00. The scaffolding has been duly secured to prevent unauthorised individuals from climbing it.
